- Extent to which the nominee has had a profound and enduring effect on a significant part of local, statewide or national community;
- Extent to which the nominee's work or programs enhance(s) Mississippi's image; and
- In the case of awards given to individuals, the appropriateness of the award at this point in his/her career; the award goes to artists whose careers span a significant amount of time or body of work.

On one 8½" x 11" sheet of paper, provide a one and one-half spaced, single-page narrative which outlines your reasons for making the nomination (please do not attach additional pages to narrative and do not use a font size less than 12).

**Please note:** A completed nomination application and narrative are mandatory for nomination consideration. This information is critical as it will be used as the basis for publicity about the nominee if chosen for an award.
