Essential Questions

Do numbers have a specific order?
How do you identify and describe 2D shapes?

I can identify numbers and count in the correct order.
I can name a variety of 2D shapes in various sizes and directions based on attributes.

Lesson:

Step 1: The students viewed Kandinsky's *Composition VIII* and identified a variety of 2D shapes seen in his art. After identifying shapes, we discussed other elements found like lines and color. Students voted on what our masterpiece should be titled. *Composition 4K WON!!!*

Step 2: To begin, our students cut out several geometric shapes from a variety of materials such as wallpaper, felt, and construction paper. Each shape had a different

texture. The teacher asked students to identify their shape based on characteristics described to them.

Step 3: We discussed the type of paint we were using and painting techniques. Students chose which shape and color they would like to add to our canvas. They placed the stencil on the canvas and painted. Once each student painted a shape, we compared our shapes to *Composition VI II*.

Step 4: Students worked together to place the 2D shape creations on the canvas. Before they placed it on there, they identified the position in which the shape would be placed.
