Essential Questions

Lesson:

TSW use previously learned vocabulary words from ELA and Art Elements to discuss how they relate to an art print.

The vocabulary words are printed on cards and TSW lay the words on the art print as they feel it relates.

TSW hold discussions how and why that word can be used to analyze and portray the decisions made by the artist, art techniques and meaning of the picture/print.

TSW form sentences, that include context clues, with the chosen vocabulary words.

TSW check their sentences for writing corrections (spelling, punctuation, grammar).

The class has a discussion on what words were chosen and why; including sentences they formed.
